## RE: Cambie Bridge Improvements

Dear Resident and/or Business Owner,

In June 2018, the City will make upgrades to the Cambie Bridge to improve comfort and safety for people walking and cycling. Upgrades will include:

- Installing a southbound protected bike lane on Cambie Bridge and the W 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave off-ramp;
- Separating people cycling and walking on the existing east path with a painted line;
- Removing southbound cycling on the east path; and
- Improving connections at the south end of the Cambie Bridge.

### What to Expect During Construction:

*Closures for vehicles:* Closures are scheduled on weekends and weekdays outside of peak hours to minimize traffic impacts, and will impact:

- The off-ramp onto W 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave
- Two southbound travel lanes on Cambie Bridge

*Access maintained:* Access for people walking and cycling will be maintained but may require crossing to an opposite side of the bridge.

*Schedule & Working Hours:* Working hours will be Monday to Friday from 7:00 am and 3:30 pm, with additional work during weekends to ensure timely completion. Work schedule is subject to change.

*Noise & Vibration:* Some noise and vibration is to be expected during construction.

### Background:

Cambie Bridge provides a critical link between BC's two largest economic centres and high density neighbourhoods, and has large volumes of people who walk and cycle across it. The City's Transportation 2040 Plan identified it as a priority location to improve comfort and safety for people walking and cycling.

We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you in advance for your cooperation and patience. We will make every effort to minimize the impact of our work on your daily routines. During construction, please feel free to discuss any immediate concerns you may have with the crew on site, as they will be happy to assist you.
